

EXHIBIT GUIDELINES

Eligibility:

Winona Arts Center Members.
Any work completed in the past two years that has not been previously shown at the Winona Arts Center. No entry fee.

Theme: Earth Day / Sun-Day

Works associated with the earth or sun. Landscapes, images of plants, and animals, water, sunsets, sunrises or colors associated with the sun or earth. The art work can be political or may address concerns about pollution or other environmental threats. Art work can be about solar energy or other ideas about the sun's energy. Interpret the theme as you see fit.

Media: All media are eligible. Because the gallery is a multi-use space, there is a limited space for large sculpture. If you plan to enter a large sculpture, notify Mary Coughlan in advance to insure adequate space.

Number of Works: Artists may enter one art work.

Size: 2-D art works may be up to 4' x 6'.

Framing: 2-D artwork must be framed and ready to hang. Framed work must have a wire or metal saw-tooth fastener to hang the picture. Fiber work or other wall pieces must have wire or supplied hanging devices.

Sale of Art Work: Art may be for sale or for exhibit only. There will be a 25% commission on works sold from the exhibit.

All decisions made by the Gallery Committee regarding the suitability of work for exhibition will be final. Although the utmost care will be taken in handling works for the exhibition, the WAC and exhibit organizers will not be held liable for loss or damage of art work. It is the responsibility of the artists to insure their own work.

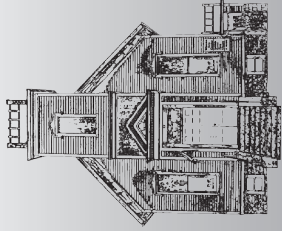
